## For Universities/Institutes/Colleges/Schools

- All Universities/Institutes/Colleges/Schools having valid AISHE/U-DISE/NCVT/SCVT codes, located in & outside the State/UT whose students avail these scholarships are advised to register themselves and get their KYC and Aadhaar Demo-Authentication done at the earliest. They are also advised to get their courses details updated on the NSP at the earliest so that their students can apply and they can verify such applications on the Portal within the timelines. The timelines need to be adhered to strictly.
